

Hamley Bridge Primary School Behaviour Expectations

Learning:

- Be ready for learning
- Listen to and follow teacher instructions
- Join in and “have a go”
- Do your best work
- Seek help when you need it
- Maintain appropriate noise level in class
- Be responsible for your own behaviour
- When learning is tricky—don’t give up

Safety:

- Look after yourself and others
- Solve problems without violence (body or spoken words)
- Move safely inside buildings
- “Safe hands and safe feet”
- Wear sunsafe hats and clothes
- Stay where a school adult can easily see you
- Line up outside the classroom without touching other students

Respect for Property:

- Take care of school property
- Take care of your own and other people’s property
- If you make a mess—you clean it up
- Keep the toilets clean and tidy
- Put rubbish in the bin
- Students bring personal items at their own risk (including jewellery)

Relationships:

- Listen to each other
- Be friendly and fair towards others
- Care for others
- Help each other

Communication:

- Speak politely at all times
- Use positive body language and tone of voice
- One person speaks at a time

Attendance:

- Come to school whenever possible
- Quickly go to class when the bell goes
- Let the school know why you are away or late (parents do this)

Dress Code:

- Wear school colours whenever possible
- Wear shoes that are safe for physical activity
- Make up is discouraged

Food:

Sharing of food is discouraged. Lollies are not to be brought to school and shared.

Positive feedback

Positive communication with family

Stickers

Move up on step charts, happy charts, etc

Virtues cards

Principal Awards

“Every Day Safe Play”

Extra free choice activities

Participation in special school/class activities

Range of responses to negative behaviour:



Warnings/reminders

Apologise to person impacted by behaviour

Time out—buddy class/office or “sit out” on metal bench

Catch up missed work at recess or lunch

School based “community service” - clean up, etc

Parent/carer contacted (verbal or written)

Restricted Play or Not invited to join in with some activities

Take home or Suspension (at school or at home)
